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## **NATIONAL FOREWORD**

### **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

This standard was adopted by sensory evaluation technical committee, under the supervision of Food and Agriculture Standards Divisional committee (AFDC).

This draft Tanzania standard is identical to ISO 8586:2012(E) – Sensory analysis — General guidelines for the selection, training and monitoring of selected assessors and expert sensory assessors, which was published by International Organization for Standardization.

### **TERMINOLOGY AND CONVENTIONS.**

This text of International standard, if found suitable, may be approved for publication as Tanzania standard without deviations.

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania standards: attention is drawn especially to the following: -

1. The comma has been used as decimal marker for Metric dimensions. In Tanzania standards, it's currently practice to use "full point" on the baseline as decimal marker.
2. Where the words "International standard (s)" appear, referring to this standard they should read "Tanzania Standard(s)".

## **SCOPE**

This International Standard specifies criteria for the selection and procedures for the training and monitoring of selected assessors and expert sensory assessors.

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
