Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS) has great pleasure to announce the **4th ARSO ESSAY COMPETITION for 2017**. The competition is open to all college and higher learning institution students below the age of 35 years old pursuing their studies in Tanzania.

THEME: "Role of Standardization in Facilitating Human Rights with particular focus on the Rights of Women"

PRIZES:

- **National level:** Computer, Tablet, Smartphone and Tshs 300,000/= for the 4th and 5th runner up.
- **Regional Level:** USD 200, USD 300 and USD 500
- **Continental Level:** USD 500, USD 800 and USD 1000
- Winners will be given a trip and accommodation to the ARSO General Assembly

ENTRY RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. This competition is open to all Tanzanians below the age of 35 years old living in Tanzania and studying at any university/college recognized by the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU).

2. **Length of essays:** Essays should be between 1000 and 1200 words.

3. **Presentation:** Essays should be double spaced and presented in Century Gothic, size 12.

4. **Language:** Essays should be in English language.

5. **Information about the author:** An Author may use up to 50 words to describe himself/herself. Information should include author's full names, course and year of study, town in which his/her university or college is located. **(N. B: this will not be part of the 1000 - 1200 words)**

6. **Contacts of the author:** An Author should provide postal, physical, telephone and email addresses on the first page of the essay together

with the title of the essay. Participants are kindly required to attach a copy of Identity Card and a completely filled registration form that can be obtained from the ARSO website www.arso-oran.org

7. Eligibility

The following essays are not eligible for this competition:

- Essays that have been shown or accepted for other competitions.
- Essays that have been published in any form.
- Essays that focus on the work of a particular person, organization or brand name.

8. Number of essays to be submitted: Participants are allowed to submit only one essay.

All essays and registration forms should be submitted through essay@tbs.go.tz before **13th February 2017**.
