NATIONAL FOREWORD

0. This Tanzania Standard is a verbatim identity of ISO 14015: 2001- Environmental assessment of sites and organizations (EASO), published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

0.1 Terminology and Conventions

The text of the International Standard is hereby being recommended to be approved for publication as a Tanzania standard without deviation. Some terminology and certain conversion are not identical with those used in Tanzania Standards; attention is drawn to the following:

Comma (,) has been used as decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania, it is current practice to use a full point (.) on the baseline as a decimal marker.

Wherever the words "International Standard" appear in this standard, they should be interpreted as "Tanzania Standard".

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0.2 Scope

This standard was last reviewed and confirmed by the international organization for standardization in 2007. Therefore, this version of 2001 remains the same.

EASO is an assessment which helps an organization to understand environmental issues associated with their sites and activities, and their associated business consequences.

This standard provides guidance on how to conduct an EASO through a systematic process of identifying environmental aspects and environmental issues and determining, if appropriate, their business consequences.

It can be used by all organizations, including small and medium sized enterprises, operation anywhere in the world. It can be used for self-assessment as well as external assessment.

The users of this standard are expected to be Industry, past, present and possible future users of a particular sites and organizations with financial interest in the industry or site example; banks, insurance companies and investors.

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
