0. This Tanzania Standard is a verbatim identity of ISO 14050: 2006-Environmental management —Vocabulary, published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

0.1 Terminology and Conventions

The text of the International Standard is hereby being recommended to be approved for publication as a Tanzania standard without deviation. Some terminology and certain conversion are not identical with those used in Tanzania Standards; attention is drawn to the following:

Comma (,) has been used as decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania, it is current practice to use a full point (.) on the baseline as a decimal marker.

Wherever the words “International Standard” appear in this standard, they should be interpreted as “Tanzania Standard”.

Scope

This international standard was last reviewed and confirmed in 2017. Therefore, this version of 2009 remains the same.

It contains concepts and their definitions as used in the 14000 series of International Standards related to environmental management. This standard is also intended to be used by standards developers as an aid to maintaining consistency.

It is presented in three official ISO languages, English, French and Russian (ISO 14050:2009 E/F/R). It also gives the equivalent terms in Spanish, Arabic, German, Finnish, Italian, Dutch, Norwegian, Portuguese and Swedish.
