The Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS) has been mandated by Environmental Management Act of 2004 to formulate environmental quality standards as per Section 140 of the Act. The formulation of these standards is in accordance to the Standards Act of 2009. Preparation of standards is done through committees consisting wide range of expertise. Stakeholder's comments is among the stages for finalization of the standards. In this regard the following standards; one national standard and seven international standards which are intended to be adopted are hereby attached for your comments.

Therefore, we hereby request your comments and opinions on adopting these revised international standards whose scopes are attached herein:

EMDC 5(5546) P3/ TZS 1401:2011 (ISO 2041:2009) Mechanical vibration, shock and conditional monitoring – Vocabulary
