RE: STANDARDS FOR STAKEHOLDERS COMMENTS

The Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS) has been mandated by Environmental Management Act of 2004 to formulate environmental quality standards as per Section 140 of the Act. The formulation of these standards is in accordance to the Standards Act of 2009. Preparation of standards is done through committees consisting wide range of expertise. Stakeholder's comments are among the stages for finalization of the standards. In this regard the following five draft standards which are intended to be developed/revise as Tanzania Standards are hereby attached for your comments.

EMDC 1 (4633) P3/ REV TZS 860: 2006: Municipal and Industrial waste water: General tolerance limits

EMDC 1 (5096) P3: Tolerance limits for industrial effluents discharged into inland surface water – Oil and gas.

EMDC 1 (5081) P3: Tolerance limits for industrial effluents discharged into inland surface water – Pulp and paper mills

EMDC 8 (5538) P3: Solid waste management - waste tyres

EMDC 8 (5537) P3: Solid waste management – non-hazardous waste

The comments should be specific, and the relevant clause(s) ought to be quoted against the comments. Wherever possible give the preferred wording. If the drafts are generally acceptable, the Bureau will also appreciate if you say so, preferably by 18th June 2018. A form for filling in the comments is attached herein. These draft standards are for comments only and shall not be used as Tanzania Standards.
