0 National Foreword

This draft Tanzania Standard is being prepared by the Electrical Installations Technical Committee, under the supervision of the Electrical Engineering Divisional Standards Committee (EEDC)

This draft Tanzania Standard is an adoption of the International Standard IEC 61386-21:2002 *Conduits systems for cable management –Part 21: Particular Requirements-Rigid conduit systems*, which has been prepared by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC).

Terminology and conventions

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania Standards; Attention is drawn especially to the following:

- 1) The comma has been used as a decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania Standards, it is current practice to use “full point” on the baseline as the decimal marker.
- 2) Where the words “International Standard(s)” appear, referring to this standard they should read “Tanzania Standard(s)”.

Scope

This draft Tanzania standard specifies the requirements for rigid conduit systems. This part 21, which specifies particular requirements for rigid conduit systems, is to be used in conjunction with IEC 61386-1, Conduit systems for electrical installations – Part 1: General requirements, and its amendments.
