NATIONAL FOREWORD

1.0 INTRODUCTION

This draft standard was adopted by Tobacco and Tobacco products technical committee, under the supervision of Food and Agriculture Standards Divisional committee (AFDC).

This draft standard specifies the method of conducing a survey to determine nicotine-free dry particulate matter and nicotine yields from fine-cut smoking articles made by consumers.

It is identical to ISO 21147:2003 Fine-cut tobacco and smoking articles made from it — Survey and analysis of consumer-made articles which was published by International Organization for Standardization.

TERMINOLOGY AND CONVENTIONS.

This text of International standard, if found suitable, may be approved for publication as Tanzania standard without deviations.

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania standards: attention is drawn especially to the following: -

- 1. The comma has been used as decimal marker for Metric dimensions. In Tanzania standards, it's currently practice to use "full point" on the baseline as decimal marker.
- 2. Where the words "International standard (s)" appear, referring to this standard they should read "Tanzania Standard(s)".
