NATIONAL FOREWORD

1.0 INTRODUCTION

This draft standard was adopted by Tobacco and Tobacco products technical committee, under the supervision of Food and Agriculture Standards Divisional committee (AFDC).

This draft standard specifies the general principles to be applied when sampling batches of raw tobacco in order to assess either

- the mean value of one or more of its characteristics, or
- the heterogeneity of one or more of its characteristics.

This draft standard is applicable to the sampling of batches of raw tobacco of the following types:

leaf tobacco: (flue cured, air cured, sun cured and fire cured) and pretreated raw tobacco.

It is identical to ISO 4874:2020 Tobacco — Sampling of batches of raw material — General principles which was published by International Organization for Standardization.

TERMINOLOGY AND CONVENTIONS.

This text of International standard, if found suitable, may be approved for publication as Tanzania standard without deviations.

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania standards: attention is drawn especially to the following: -

1. The comma has been used as decimal marker for Metric dimensions. In Tanzania standards, it's currently practice to use "full point" on the baseline as decimal marker.
2. Where the words "International standard (s)" appear, referring to this standard they should read "Tanzania Standard(s)".
