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## **National foreword**

### **1.0 Introduction**

- 1.1** This Draft Tanzania Standard is being reviewed by the Leather and leather products Technical committee, under the supervision of Leather Technology Division Standards Committee.
- 1.2** This Draft Tanzania Standard is identical to ISO 15703 - 1: 1998 which was last reviewed and confirmed on 2018 (Leather — Tests for colour fastness — Colour fastness to mild washing).
- 1.3** The text of the International Standard is hereby being recommended for approval without deviation for publication as Draft Tanzania Standard.

### **2.0 Terminologies and conventions**

If terminologies and conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania Standards; attention is drawn especially to the following: -

The comma has been used as a decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania Standards, it is current practice to use “full point” on the baseline as the decimal marker.

Where the words “International Standard(s)” appear, referring to this Draft Tanzania Standard they should read “Draft Tanzania Standard(s)”.

## **1 SCOPE**

This International Standard specifies a method for determining the resistance of leather to mild washing under specified conditions.

The method is suitable for assessing the change in colour of the leather, the staining of an adjacent textile fabric and any change in the finish of the leather.

This method can also be used leather preparation for assessing the change in any other physical or chemical property during mild washing.
