This Tanzania standard is identical adoption of ISO 16624:2020 Wheat flour and durum wheat Semolina-Determination of colour by diffuse reflectance colorimetry published by the International Organization for Standardization

TERMINOLOGY AND CONVENTIONS.

The text of International standard is hereby being recommended for approval without deviation for publication as draft Tanzania standard.

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania Standards; attention is drawn especially to the following: -

- 1. The comma has been used as decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania, it is current practice to use "full point" on the baseline as decimal marker.
- 2. Whenever the words "International Standard" appear, referring to this draft standard, they should read as "Tanzania Standard".

Scope

This document specifies a method for the determination of colour in durum wheat semolina and wheat flour by diffuse reflectance colorimetry. It is applicable to industrial semolina and flour. The method can be applicable to flour obtained from experimental mill.
