Lighting of work places part 3 - Lighting requirements for safety and security of outdoor work places

National foreword

The Tanzania Bureau of Standards is the statutory national standards' body for Tanzania, established under the Act. No.3 of 1975, amended by Act. No. 2 of 2009.

This draft Tanzania standard is being prepared by Radiation Technical Committee, under the supervision of the Environmental Management Divisional Standards Committee (EMDC)

This Tanzania Standard is identical to ISO 8995-3, Lighting of work places part 1 – Indoors published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

Terminology and conventions

Some terminology and certain conventions in the ISO standards are not identical with those used in Tanzania Standards and attention is drawn to the following:

the comma (,) has been used as a decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania Standards, it is current practice to use a full point (.) on the base line as the decimal marker and

wherever the words "International Standard" appear in this Tanzania Standard, they should be interpreted as "Tanzania Standard".

This document specifies the lighting requirements which will contribute to the visual needs for safety and security within outdoor work places.
