### NATIONAL FOREWORD

The Tanzania Bureau of Standards is a statutory national standards body for Tanzania, established under the Act.No.3 of 1975, amended by Act.No.2 of 2009.

This Tanzania standard is being prepared by Coffee and Coffee Product Technical Committee, under the supervision of Agriculture and Food Standards Divisional Committee (AFDC).

This Tanzania standard is identical adoption of ISO 18794:2018 Coffee—Sensory analysis—Vocabulary published by the Technical Committee ISO/TC 34/SC 15 of International Organization for Standardization.

### TERMINOLOGY AND CONVENTIONS.

The text of international standard is hereby being recommended for approval without deviation for publication as Tanzania standard.

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania standards: attention is drawn especially to the following: -

- 1) The comma has been used as decimal marker for Metric dimensions. In Tanzania standards, it's currently practice to use "full point" on the baseline as decimal marker.
- 2) Where the words "International Standard(s)" appear, referring to this standard they should read "Tanzania Standard(s)".

#### **SCOPE**

This document defines terms relating to coffee sensory analysis.

This document covers definitions applicable to green, roasted and ground coffee, coffee extracts and soluble coffee.

The terms are given under the following headings:

- a) basic terms of sensory analysis;
- b) generic terms in the sensory assessment of coffee;
- c) terminology relating to coffee-specific odours and tastes;
- d) terms commonly used in sensory assessment of coffee by practitioners.
