### NATIONAL FOREWORD

The Tanzania Bureau of Standards is a statutory national standards body for Tanzania, established under the Act.No.3 of 1975, amended by Act.No.2 of 2009.

This Tanzania standard is being prepared by Coffee and Coffee Product Technical Committee, under the supervision of Agriculture and Food Standards Divisional Committee (AFDC).

This Tanzania standard is identical adoption of ISO 18601:2013 (Confirmed in 2018) Packaging and the environment-General requirements for the use of ISO standards in the field of packaging and the environment published by the Technical Committee ISO/TC 122/SC 4 of International Organization for Standardization.

### TERMINOLOGY AND CONVENTIONS.

The text of international standard is hereby being recommended for approval without deviation for publication as Tanzania standard.

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania standards: attention is drawn especially to the following: -

- 1) The comma has been used as decimal marker for Metric dimensions. In Tanzania standards, it's currently practice to use "full point" on the baseline as decimal marker.
- 2) Where the words "International Standard(s)" appear, referring to this standard they should read "Tanzania Standard(s)".

### SCOPE

This International Standard specifies requirements and procedures for the other International Standards in this series on packaging and the environment: ISO18602, ISO18603, ISO18604, ISO18605, and ISO18606.

This International Standard is applicable to a supplier responsible for placing packaging or packaged goods on the market
