#### NATIONAL FOREWORD

The Tanzania Bureau of Standards is a statutory national standards body for Tanzania, established under the Act.No.3 of 1975, amended by Act.No.2 of 2009.

This Tanzania standard is being prepared by Coffee and Coffee Product Technical Committee, under the supervision of Agriculture and Food Standards Divisional Committee (AFDC).

This Tanzania standard is identical adoption of ISO 7348:1992 (Confirmed in 2021) Glass Containers-Manufacture-Vocabulary published by the Technical Committee ISO/TC 63 of International Organization for Standardization.

#### TERMINOLOGY AND CONVENTIONS.

The text of international standard is hereby being recommended for approval without deviation for publication as Tanzania standard.

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania standards: attention is drawn especially to the following: -

- 1) The comma has been used as decimal marker for Metric dimensions. In Tanzania standards, it's currently practice to use "full point" on the baseline as decimal marker.
- 2) Where the words "International Standard(s)" appear, referring to this standard they should read "Tanzania Standard(s)".

### **SCOPE**

This International Standard defines terms relating to the manufacture of glass Containers, to the materials used and to the processes and products associated with such manufacture.

This International Standard deals with terms relating to the manufacture and processing of Containers, i.e., bottles and jars, made from soda-lime-silica glass by an automatic or semi-automatic process. It does not concern terms relating to the manufacture of any other type of glass Container, such as laboratory beakers or flasks, or any item of domestic glassware, such as tumblers or decanters.
