## **0 National Foreword**

This draft Tanzania Standard is being prepared by the Renewable Energy Technical Committee, under the supervision of the Electrical Engineering Divisional Standards Committee (EEDC)

This draft Tanzania Standard is an adoption of the International Standard ISO 50002:2014, *Energy audits Requirements with guidance for use*, which has been prepared by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

### **Terminology and conventions**

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania Standards; Attention is drawn especially to the following:

- 1) The comma has been used as a decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania Standards, it is current practice to use “full point” on the baseline as the decimal marker.
- 2) Where the words “International Standard(s)” appear, referring to this standard they should read “Tanzania Standard(s)”.

## **Scope**

This Tanzania standard specifies the process requirements for carrying out an energy audit in relation to energy performance. It is applicable to all types of establishments and organizations, and all forms of energy and energy use.

It specifies the principles of carrying out energy audits, requirements for the common processes during energy audits, and deliverables for energy audits.

The standard does not address the requirements for selection and evaluation of the competence of bodies providing energy audit services, and it does not cover the auditing of an organization's energy management systems.

It also provides informative guidance on its use.
