### 1.0 Introduction

1.1 This Draft Tanzania Standard is being adopted by the Hospital Textiles Technical Committee, under the supervision of Textiles and Leather Division Standards Committee.

1.2 This Draft Tanzania Standard is identical to **ISO 11948-1:1996 Urine-absorbing aids - Part 1: Whole-product testing** Published by International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

1.3 This Draft Tanzania Standard is the first edition.

1.4 The text of the International Standard is hereby being recommended for approval without deviation for publication as Draft Tanzania Standard.

### 2.0 Terminologies and conventions

If terminologies and conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania Standards; attention is drawn especially to the following: -

The comma has been used as a decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania Standards, it is current practice to use “full stop” on the baseline as the decimal marker.

Where the words “International Standard(s)” appear, referring to this Draft Tanzania Standard they should read “Draft Tanzania Standard(s)”.

## Scope

This Part of ISO 11948 specifies a method for determining the absorption capacity of the absorbent core of body worn urine-absorbing aids.

NOTE Other methods for measuring absorption capacity examine aspects which are outside the scope of this part of ISO 11948

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
