This draft Tanzania standard is being prepared by the Exploration Technical Committee (MMDC 1), under the supervision of the Mining and Minerals Standards Divisional Committee (MMDC).

This draft Tanzania standard is the identical adoption of **Graphical symbols for use on detailed maps**, **plans and geological cross-sections - Part 4: Representation of metamorphic rocks** which was prepared **by ISO/TC 82 Mining**.

The ISO standard title on the cover page has been written in bilingual, for the purpose of this Tanzania standard only English text of the title should be used.

This draft Tanzania standard includes graphitic rocks symbol — when being represented in the map that were not considered in the ISO standard.

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania standards; attention is drawn especially to the following:

- The comma has been used as a decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania Standards, it is current practice to use "full point" on the baseline as the decimal marker.
- Wherever the words 'International Standard' appears in the text, referring to this draft Standard, they should read as 'Tanzania Standard'
