This Tanzania standard is being prepared by Meat, poultry, eggs, game and their products Technical Committee, under the supervision of Agriculture and Food Standards Divisional Committee (AFDC).

This Tanzania standard is identical adoption of ISO 19643:2026 Meat and meat products - Determination of nitrite and nitrate content - Continuous flow analysis (CFA) method published by the Technical Committee ISO 34/SC 06 of International Organization for Standardization.

TERMINOLOGY AND CONVENTIONS.

The text of international standard is hereby being recommended for approval without deviation for publication as Tanzania standard.

Some terminologies and certain conventions are not identical with those used in Tanzania standards: attention is drawn especially to the following: -

- 1) The comma has been used as decimal marker for Metric dimensions. In Tanzania standards, it's currently practice to use "full point" on the baseline as decimal marker.
- 2) Where the words "International Standard(s)" appear, referring to this standard they should read "Tanzania Standard(s)".

SCOPE

This document specifies the determination of nitrite and nitrate content by continuous flow analysis (CFA) method in meat, poultry and their products.
