DRAFT TANZANIA STANDARD

0. National foreword

The Tanzania Bureau of Standards is the statutory national standards body for Tanzania, established under the Act.No.3 of 1975, amended by Act.No.2 of 2009.

This Draft Tanzania standard is being prepared by Environmental Management Systems Technical Committee, under the supervision of the Environmental Management Divisional Standards Committee (EMDC)

This Draft Tanzania Standard is identical to ISO 16000-40:2016 Indoor air - Part 40: Indoor air quality management system published by the International Organization for Standardization(ISO)

Terminology and conventions

The text of the International Standard is hereby being recommended for approval without deviation for publication as draft Tanzania standard. Some terminology and certain conversion are not identical with those used in Tanzania Standards; attention is drawn to the following:

The comma (,) has been used as decimal marker for metric dimensions. In Tanzania, it is current practice to use a full point (.) on the baseline as a decimal marker.

Wherever the words "International Standard" appear, referring to this draft standard, they should read as "Tanzania Standard".

1.SCOPE

This document specifies requirements for an indoor air quality management system. It is applicable to any organization that wishes to:

- a) establish a system for the management of the quality of indoor air
- b) implement, maintain and continually improve the indoor air quality management system;
- c) ensure conformity to the indoor air quality management system;
- d) demonstrate conformity to this document.
